The World record for the biggest ever picnic is 8000 people set in Tenerife, Spain on 2<sup>nd</sup> May 1999.

Our aim is to show our support for Fair Trade by breaking this record and creating the world's **LARGEST EVER FAIR TRADE PICNIC**.

This means we need about 400 people picnicking in each Local Authority area!

There will be three days dedicated to picnics- from Friday 29<sup>th</sup> June to Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> July. For more information including how to organise a picnic, ideas, recipes, a poster and press release please read on...!

## How to organise your BIG Fair Trade picnic

1. **Get together a good group of people** who can help to organise the event; prepare food, arrange games, create posters and contact the media
2. **Plan the event** and create a timeline of what needs to be done and when. Use the example below for guidance. Think of the practicalities:
  - Where will the picnic be held?
  - If it is in a public place, do you require permission from the council?
  - How many people will be there?
  - Does everyone bring their own food and drink, or will you supply it, or sell it?
  - Will you charge to come to the event?

Assign tasks within your group. And most of all **plan a picnic that will really capture people's imagination!** There will be a prize for the best picnic in Wales!

3. **Post your event on the Fair Trade Wales website** so that everyone knows what's going on and where: [www.fairtradewales.com](http://www.fairtradewales.com)
4. To get the numbers to break the world record we need to get as many groups on board as possible picnicking over the same weekend To do this you need to try and **advertise the Big Fair Trade Picnic**. Contact local schools and community groups, put up posters and try and get as many people as possible involved! Ask them to your event or invite them to start their own.
5. This is a great chance to raise the profile of Fairtrade! **Contact the local newspapers**, radio and TV to tell them what's going on and why. You can use the attached press release to adapt and send out 1 month before the event to attract more picnickers. Remind the media again a week before your picnic. After the event, send follow up statistics to the papers (eg 200 cups of Fair Trade tea drunk), along with a good photo.
6. The day itself- Be prepared for rain with umbrellas, raincoats or a back up plan! Incorporate games into the event. Be sure to have a good time and take a record of how many people turned up. **Get everyone to sign the Fair Trade Wales petition**, and get this signed by someone respectable so it can count towards the record attempt!
7. Make sure there is assigned photographer who can catch it all on camera and send us the evidence! Brief the photographer not to take pictures of children under 16 without prior parental/guardian consent. To help them you could make them a badge.

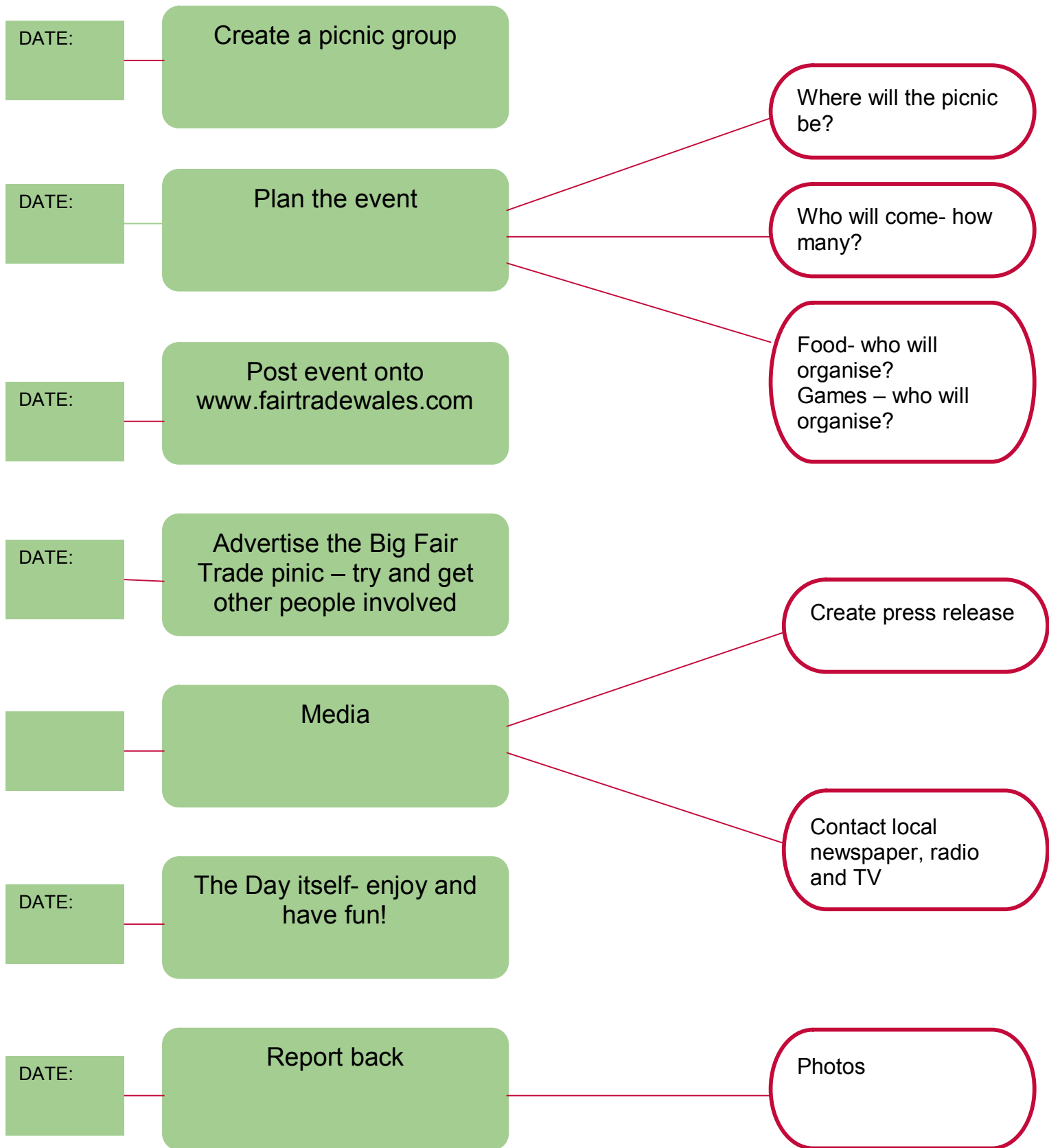

# TIMELINE





## IDEAS

The Big Fair Trade picnic is about having a great day out and promoting Fair Trade at the same time, letting everyone know how yummy it is, and helping to make Wales the world's first Fair Trade Country.

The ideas below might help you to get started...

### Where to hold the picnic?

The traditional and still one of the best places to have a picnic is in the local park. A brilliant space with potential for as many people that can squeeze into a big green field. There will also be room for children to play. In a similar vein the beach is a good setting for a pretty, if sandy, picnic.

However, to grab media attention is there anywhere more unusual than this? Could you set the picnic up on a roundabout? In the town square? On a cricket pitch (during the lunch or tea interval of a game)? In the woods? Up a mountain? It's up to you!

### Picnic with a twist?

Another way of getting a bit more attention is to add a twist to the picnic. You could give the picnic a theme - perhaps it could be a luxury picnic with everyone in evening dresses and suits? Or a World picnic with food and music from some of the different regions that Fair Trade helps. Even a Teddy Bears picnic especially for children.

### Organising the food?

A lot of thought will need to go into the food. For an easy solution just get everyone to bring along their own food to share with other people. If you take this option make sure that everyone knows to bring along at least one Fair Trade option. Alternatively you could make the food and have a small charge for people to come along, or sell food from a Fair Trade stall. There is also the option of getting local schools or catering colleges involved and seeing if they could make the food, or using a local catering outlet which uses Fair Trade ingredients. Make sure this is all planned in advance. If you are providing catering, you will need to know how many people are likely to turn up.

## Other activities?

If there are children involved it's probably a good idea to have a few games lined up to keep everyone entertained. You could have hula hoop championships, three legged races, pinatas filled with fair trade goodies and tied to trees, a fancy dress competition or for football fans a keepy-uppy competition using Fair Trade footballs!

Depending on the venue it might be possible to have a film to do with fair trade playing such as Black Gold

You could also use the opportunity to let people know what Fair Trade's all about - this could be done with a talk, some pictures or even a bit of theatre!

## How to get other people to join in?

Spread the word - tell everyone you know about it. Tap into the networks and local community groups that already exist. Email round the poster included in this pack and ask other people to do the same so that everyone knows what is going on, when and how they can get involved. This event should prove really popular as who doesn't want to spend their weekend sitting in the sun (hopefully!) with a picnic and friends.

The poster could also be put up in local shops and cafes. Try and encourage schools, colleges and youth groups to get involved. Maybe local employers could organise one for their staff's lunch break!

*“For example, cocoa producers in a Fair Trade co-operative in Ghana have installed wells to get access to safe drinking water.”*

To become a Fair Trade country there need to be active Fair Trade groups in every county in Wales and in most of the towns. Currently there are six counties and X towns.

How can we help?

2. The Wales Fair Trade Country campaign is backed by the Welsh Assembly Government. To find out more about the campaign go to [www.fairtradewales.com](http://www.fairtradewales.com) or contact the Fair Trade Development Officer for Wales, Mark Richardson on [07766 015 664].

Wales already has seven Fair Trade counties (Wrexham, Flintshire, Denbighshire, Conwy, Cardiff Rhondda Cynon Taff and Swansea). Every county in Wales now has a Fair Trade group and there's competition to become the next county to receive the title.

55 towns need to have active Fair Trade groups, currently there are 32.

### 3. Fairtrade products.

- There are now over 2000 Fairtrade certified products available in the UK. Products range from coffee and tea to wine and chocolate, even footballs and jeans!
- The FAIRTRADE mark guarantees producers have been paid fairly for their labour. Plus extra money goes to their community as a social premium; producers decide democratically to pay for improvement projects such as wells, new schools and health care.
- Fairtrade retail sales reached £195m last year. This is a growth sector, with the UK being currently the biggest consumer of Fairtrade products.

### Sun-Dried Tomato Pesto Dip

100g T. Wholefoods Sun Dried Tomatoes **FAIR TRADE**  
 200ml Olive Oil **FAIR TRADE**  
 100g Pitted Black Olives  
 2 handfuls of chopped Fresh Basil 50g Pine Nuts  
 Salt and crushed garlic to taste

1. Plunge tomatoes into warm water for 3 minutes to soften. Then drain.
2. Blend all the ingredients in a food blender, until they are well mixed.
3. Serve on either pasta, rice or baked potatoes. Also delicious as a dip for crisps, breadsticks and garlic bread.

## Basmati Rice Salad

- 2 cups basmati rice **FAIR TRADE**
- 3/4 cup Organic cashew nuts **FAIR TRADE**
- 1/2 cup dried raisins **FAIR TRADE**
- 5 tablespoons Zaytoun olive oil **FAIR TRADE**
- 4 cups water
- 1 1/3 cups thinly sliced green onions
- 1 1/2 cups thinly sliced celery
- 3/4 cup minced fresh parsley
- 1/2 cup chopped walnuts
- 5 tablespoons lemon juice
- 3 tablespoons soy sauce
- 2 1/2 teaspoons ground cumin

1. Combine 4 cups water and rice in large saucepan. Bring to boil. Cover; reduce heat and simmer until tender, about 35 minutes. Drain if necessary. Transfer rice to large bowl.
2. Mix in green onions, celery, parsley, cashew nuts, raisins and walnuts.
3. Whisk olive oil, lemon juice, soy sauce and cumin in small bowl to blend. Pour over rice salad; toss to coat.
4. Season to taste with salt and pepper and serve.

## **Fruity Sausage Roll**

From Tropical Wholefoods

- 1 Packet of Puff Pastry
- 1 Onion
- 450g Organic Sausage Meat  
(or for a vegetarian alternative - sosmix)
- 1 Tablespoon of Sunflower or Vegetable Oil
- 1 Egg Beaten
- 1 Packet of Tropical Wholefoods Mango or Papaya reconstituted in fruit juice **FAIR TRADE**

1. Pre - heat oven to 200c or 180 for fan assisted ovens. Grease a large baking sheet.
2. Chop the onion and gently fry for 5 minutes. Add the sausage meat and continue frying until cooked.
3. Take off the heat and drain through a sieve to remove excess fat. If using sosmix, then reconstitute as usual and leave to stand for 5 mins.
4. Chop fruit and add to the mixture. Allow to cool.
5. Roll out pastry into a large oblong. Put cooled mixture into centre third of pastry. Apply egg mixture to one side and fold to seal. Brush outside with beaten egg
6. Bake in oven for 20-30 mins until pastry is risen and golden.
7. Cut up and serve with salad at the picnic

## Coffee Pecan and Raisin whirls

Finely grated zest and juice of 1 orange **FAIR TRADE**

60g unrefined (golden) sugar **FAIR TRADE**

1 tablespoon warmed runny honey **FAIR TRADE**

250g bought puff pastry

½ teaspoon ground cinnamon

40g pecans

60g raisins **FAIR TRADE**

1 egg, beaten

15g melted butter

*For the icing:*

75g icing sugar

1 teaspoon instant coffee granules, dissolved in 1 tablespoon boiling water **FAIR TRADE**

1. First put raisins in a bowl with the orange juice and leave to soak for 1 hour.
2. Preheat oven to 220°C/425°F/gas mark 7.
3. Roll out the puff pastry to a square, measuring about 24cm. Brush with melted butter, leaving a 2cm gap down 2 parallel edges.
4. Mix sugar well with the cinnamon and orange zest. Break pecans into pieces about the same size as the raisins and mix into the sugar.
5. Drain the raisins and add to the sugar mixture.
6. Spread onto pastry, avoiding the gap along the 2 edges. Brush the gaps with beaten egg. Starting with one of these edges, roll up tightly like a swiss roll. Seal the edge as tightly as possible, using more beaten egg. With a sharp knife, slice the roll into 2cm wide rounds.
7. Place on a baking tray and brush top and sides with more beaten egg. Bake for 25-30 minutes until golden brown.
8. Brush tops with warmed honey straight from the oven. Transfer to a wire rack to cool.
9. Make up icing by beating the coffee into the icing sugar until smooth. When pastries are cool, drizzle with icing.

## **FAIR TRADE BANANA LOAF**

- 150 g (5 oz) caster sugar **FAIR TRADE**
- 450 g (1 lb) bananas (the gooier the better) **FAIR TRADE**
- 175 g (6 oz) mixed dried fruit **FAIR TRADE**
- 225 g (8 oz) self-raising flour
- 100 g (4 oz) butter
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 2 eggs

Pre-heat the oven to 180°C/350°F/Gas Mark 4. Peel and mash the bananas, and then mix all the ingredients except the dried fruit together. You can do this in a food processor, or by hand in a basin. When they're all thoroughly mixed, add the dried fruit. Spoon the mixture into a 1 kg (2 lb) non-stick loaf tin, spread it out evenly and bake it for 1½ hours. The loaf is done when a skewer pushed into its middle comes out clean. Cool on a wire rack before slicing.

## **FAIR TRADE BROWNIES**

Adapted from BBC

20g/<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>oz cocoa powder **FAIR TRADE**  
 150g/5oz plain chocolate **FAIR TRADE**  
 90g/3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>oz plain flour  
 150g/5oz icing sugar  
 90g/3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>oz unsalted butter, melted  
 2 tbsp golden syrup  
 2 eggs  
 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> tsp vanilla essence  
 40g/1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>oz hazelnuts, roasted, skinned and chopped

1. Preheat the oven to 180C/350F/Gas 4.
2. Grease a 25cm/10in square baking tin.
3. Stir the dry ingredients together in a large bowl.
4. Melt the chocolate carefully in a bain-marie or in a bowl over a pan of gently simmering water.
5. Add the butter and the golden syrup and stir until blended. Leave to cool to lukewarm, then stir in the eggs and vanilla essence.
6. Fold in the dry ingredients and stir rather quickly until smooth.
7. Fold in the nuts.
8. Pour the mixture into the tin.
9. Bake in the preheated oven for 30-45 minutes. The top and edges will be crusty. The inside will be slightly gooey but not runny.
10. Remove from the oven and leave to cool in the tin.
11. Cut into individual-size squares and serve while still warm. This brownie keeps for a couple of days if wrapped completely in cling film.

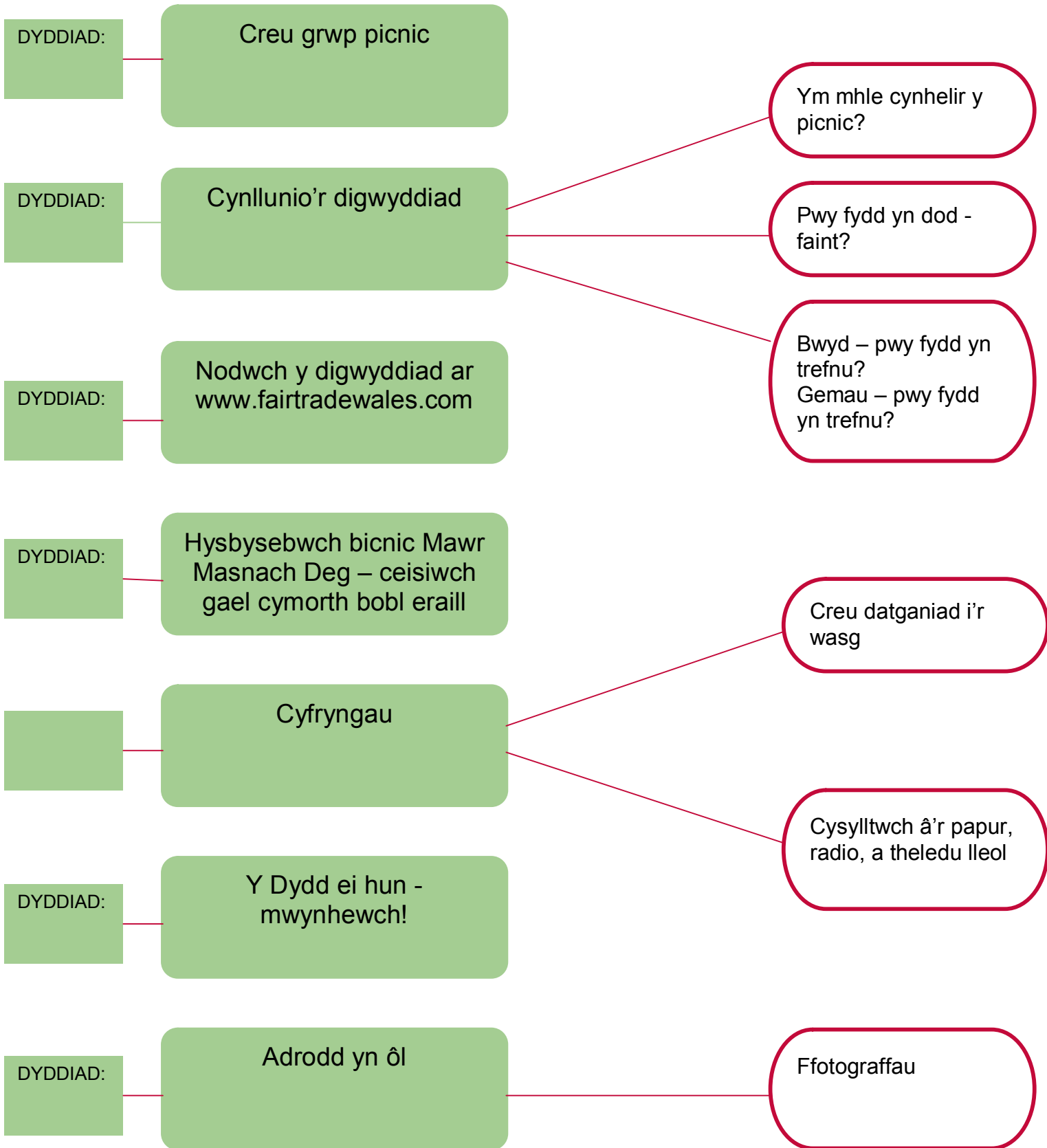

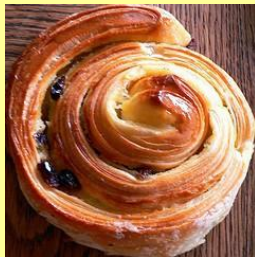
